Saturday boasts a multi-million dollar demonstration of fire fighting equipment sponsored by area fire companies.

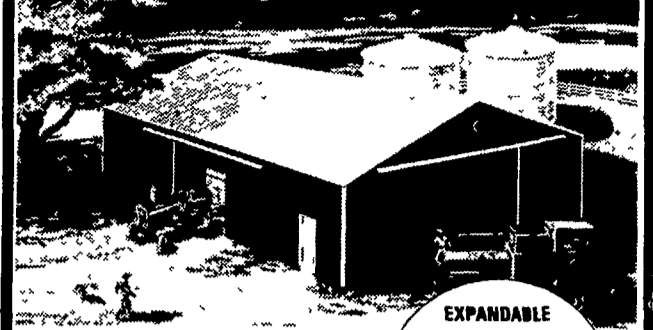
To cap off the week, a fireworks display will be shot off Saturday evening.

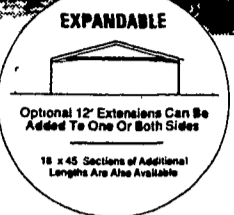

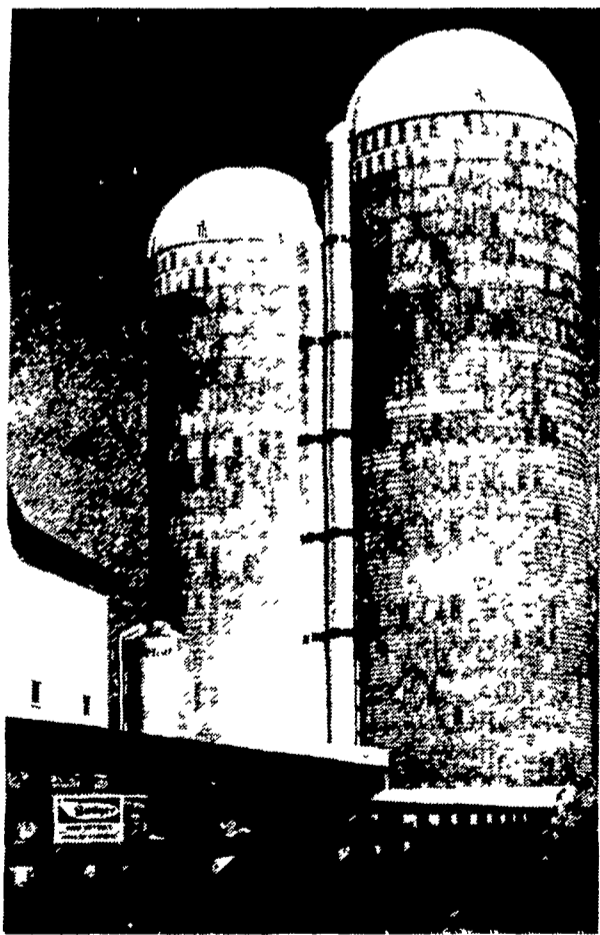

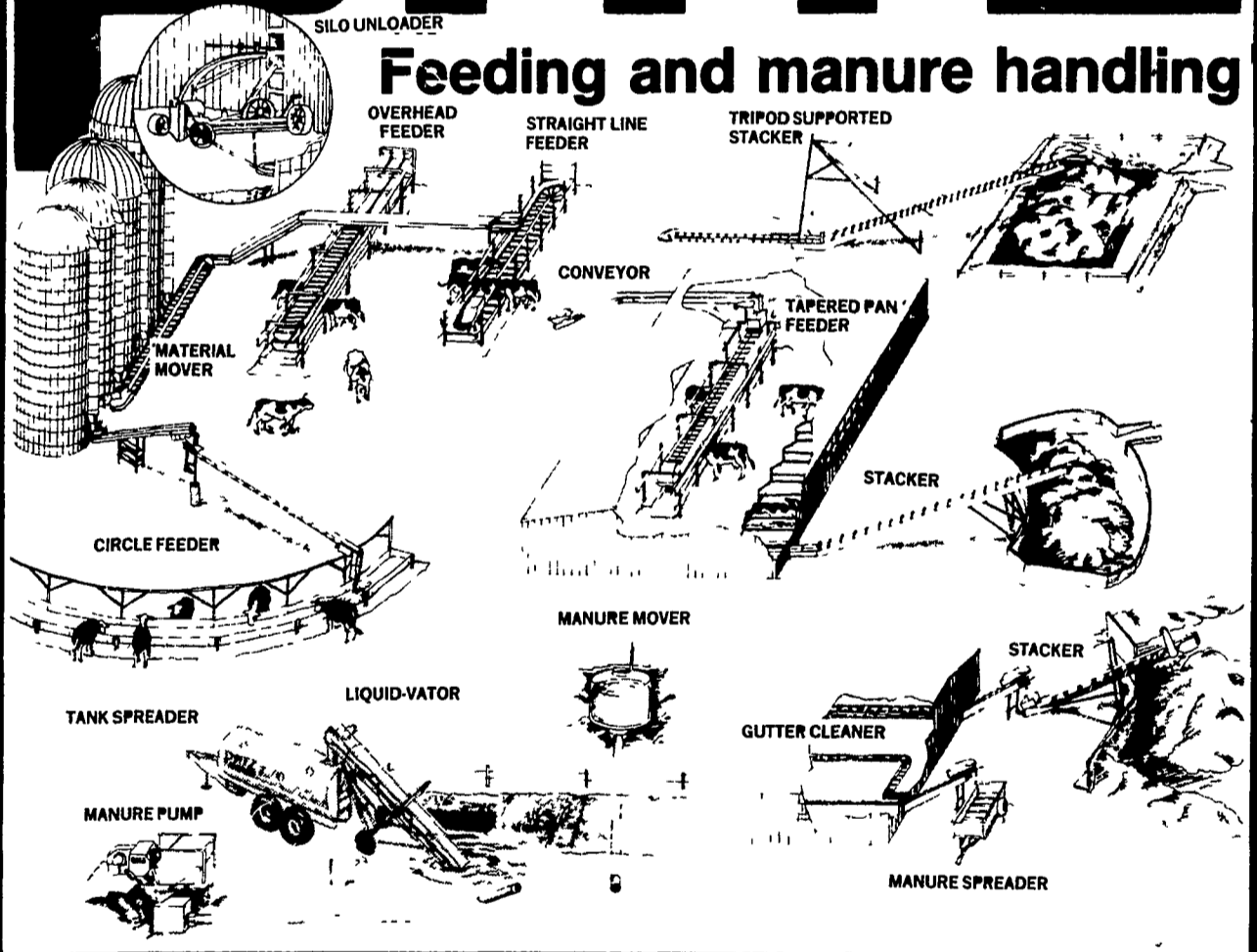
