

# Shawn Charles wins W. Lampeter hog show

LAMPETER - Shawn Charles, a 13 year old member of the Penn Manor FFA, dominated the West Lampeter Community Fair swine show by showing the champion individual animal and the champion and reserve champion pen of two pigs.

A first year member of FFA, the son of Mr and Mrs Robert Charles, Lancaster R2, the youth showed a purebred Yorkshire gilt weighing 220 lbs to the championship. The champion pen of two were heavyweight crossbred Chester Whites while the reserve champions were Duroc crossbreds. The seven swine he showed came from his cousin, Clifford Charles.

Gerald Hess, Conestoga R1, a first year FFA member, was named champion showman of the swine show. The 13 year old member, who had previously shown at the Lancaster Hog Show, also

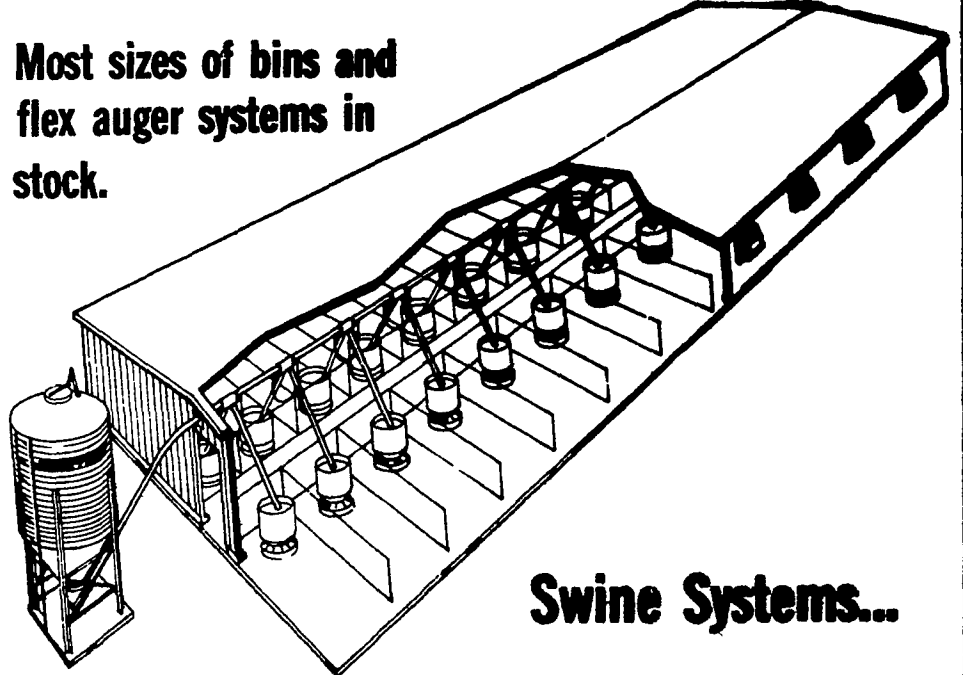
