S.E. Central Pa. consumers pay least in state for food

month survey of food basket prices conducted by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture reveals that southeast central consumers have paid the lowest average price for food in the state.

Kent Shelhamer, Pennsylvania secretary of agriculture, said that the survey indicated costs for the average "food basket" in Adams, Berks, Dauphin, Lancaster and Lebanon Counties averaged \$10.50 from March to August. During that period, the food

HARRISBURG - A six- basket cost in the region rose from \$10.08 in March to \$10.83 in July, a 75 cent increase. However, the food basket cost dropped 10 cents in August to a figure of \$10.73.

Over the six-month period, the southeast central food basket average rose 65 cents or 6.4 per cent in the region, Shelhamer said.

The survey, conducted by the Department's Bureau of Rural Affairs, compared the prices of 14 sample food basket items in both rural and urban stores from
