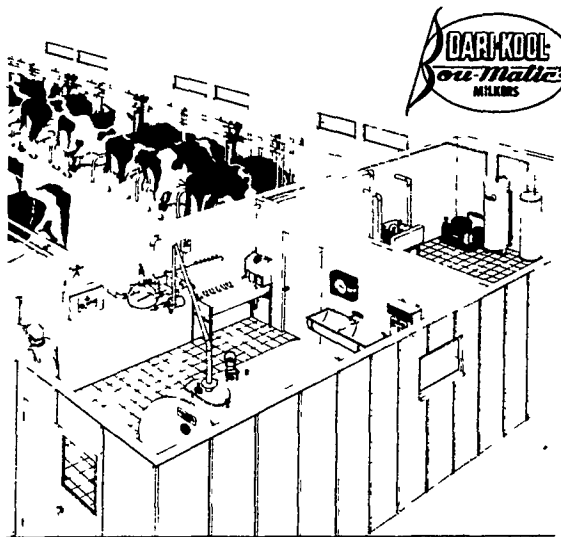
In the showing and fitting contests, James Martin, the
