

AUGUST 1977
A registered Holstein cow owned by Rhelda and Lynn Royer, 2025 Oregon Pike, Lancaster, completed the highest 305 day lactation. Sparkle produced $24,073 \mathrm{lbs}$. of milk, $1,149 \mathrm{lbs}$. of butterfat with a $4.8 \%$ test. Second high lactation was completed by a registered Holstein cow owned by Curtis E. Akers, Quarryville. Vickie produced $24,708 \mathrm{lbs}$. of milk, 1,032 lbs. of butterfat with a $3.9 \%$ test in 305 days.
The herd of R. Edwin Harnish, Christiana, had the highest daily butterfat average. This herd of 39.8 registered and grade Holsteins averaged 55.2 lbs. of milk, 2.18 lbs. of butterfat with a $3.9 \%$ test. The herd of Robert H. Kauffman, R. No. 1, Elizabethtown, placed second. This herd of 34.9 Registered Holstein cows averaged 46.4 lbs . of milk, 2.01 lbs . of butterfat with a $4.3 \%$ test.
