

Top bulls for colored breeds listed

It should be noted that just because a bull is listed here, it does not mean the bull is still in service or that semen from him is still available. It's advised that interested readers check with the bull stud at which the sire is located to find out whether the bull's semen is still safe. The first column after the bull's name is the stud code number, as assigned by the National Association of Animal Breeders. They're identified as follows:


