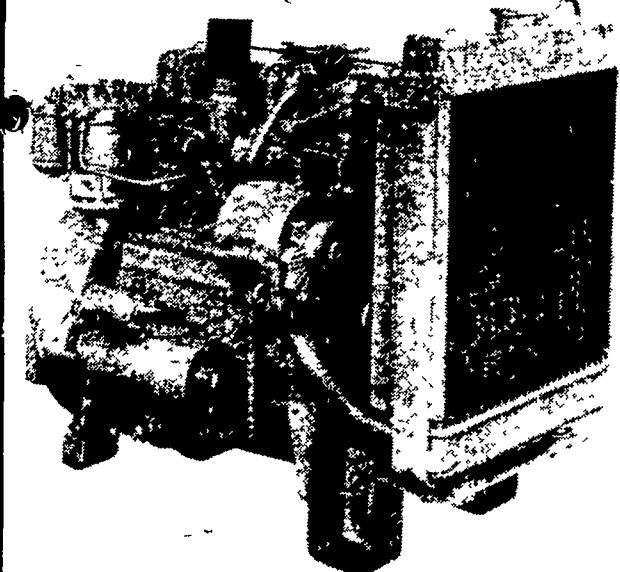

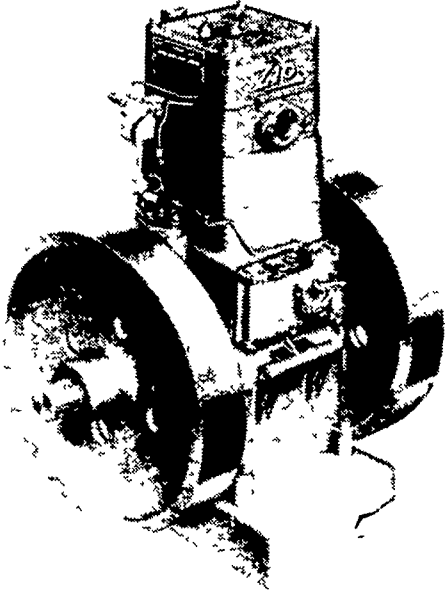

#### Making Sure

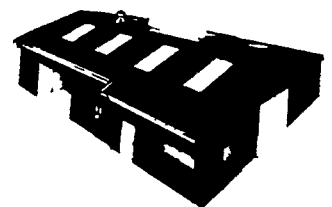
