

## Farm meeting set Dec. 6

BLOOMSBURG - Farmers from several Pennsylvania counties will gather on December 6 to discuss the current economic crisis facing American agriculture, announced Paul Zeisloft, president of Columbia County Farmers Union.

"We have invited farmers from Columbia, Luzerne, Montour, and Schuylkill counties to meet to work together to develop policy recommendations to help solve this situation," said Zeisloft.

The meeting will be held at

the Quality Inn at Buckhorn Plaza in Bloomsburg. The meeting will begin promptly at 8.

Allen Deiter, legislative specialist for the Pennsylvania Farmers Union, will be on hand to discuss state legislation affecting farmers.

The Farmers Union members will also be electing county officers for the coming year and delegates to the Pennsylvania Farmers Union state convention, which is scheduled for Jan. 23 and 24 in Harrisburg.
