Radius still 25 miles

HARRISBURG - As of now, the farm truck registration limits the use of such vehicles exclusively for farming purposes and only on highways within a 25 mile radius of the farm from which it is based.

However, there is a bill (Bill No. 1171 - Omnibus Motor Vehicle Bill) which is being considered in Pennsylvania and included in that bill is the changing of the radius distance from 25 miles to 50 miles. This is the only change that affects the farm truck registration, according to sources at the Pa. Dept. of Transportation.

This bill has passed the Pa. House of Representatives and is now being considered by the Pa. Senate Trasportation Committee. Future action on this bill at an unknown time will determine whether the registration radius of farm trucks will be changed to 50 miles.




