WEST CHESTER - The Chester County Extension Service of Penn State will have a course in Upholstery which will begin with an orientation meeting on February 28, from 9:30 - 2:30 p.m. This meeting will explain the procedures to follow in preparing chairs for reupholstering, the supplies and equipment needed. This class will be held at the Elverson National Bank Community Room, Rt. 23, Bucktown.

The workshop meetings will follow on April 25, 26, 27, 28, May 1, 2, 3, 4 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. These sessions will be held at the Ludwig's Corner Fire Hall, located on the west side of Route 100 just 1/4 mile north of the intersection of Routes 100 and 401. The workshop procedure is to bring the chair and work on it at the Fire Hall each day. Chairs may be stored at the building for the duration of the course. Two persons are

permitted to work on one chair. If bringing a partner, the cost is just for one registration. Chairs suitable to work on are boudoir and living room chairs that do not have diamond tufting or channel backs. The chair should be structurally sound
