## Order 4 base milk price \$10.65 in Jan.

ALEXANDRIA, Va. — Market Administrator Joseph D. Shine today announced a January 1978 base milk price of \$10.65 per hundredweight for the Middle Atlantic Marketing Order and an excess milk price of \$8.89. The weighted average January price is \$10.44 and the butterfat differential for the month is 11.6 cents. The January base milk price is up six cents from December and is 37 cents above the January 1977 base price. Order No. 4 prices are announced for 3.5 per cent milk f.o.b. plant location within 55 miles of Philadelphia, and also within 75 miles from the nearer of Washington, DC or Baltimore, Md. There is a

six cent direct-delivery differential applicable to producer milk received at plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia.

Shine reported that January producer milk receipts totaled 482.2 million pounds, an increase of 1.2 per cent from December, and 3.7 per cent above a year ago. Class I producer milk accounted for 58.73 per cent of total January producer deliveries, compared to 58.90 per cent in December and 61.64 per cent a year ago. Base milk represented 88.62 per cent of total January production. A total of 7,955 dairymen supplied Middle Atlantic Order handlers during the month and the average daily delivery per

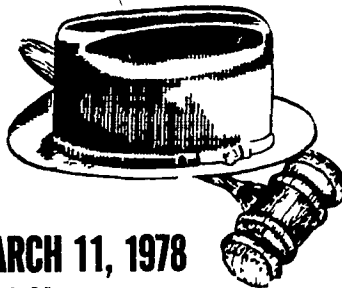
