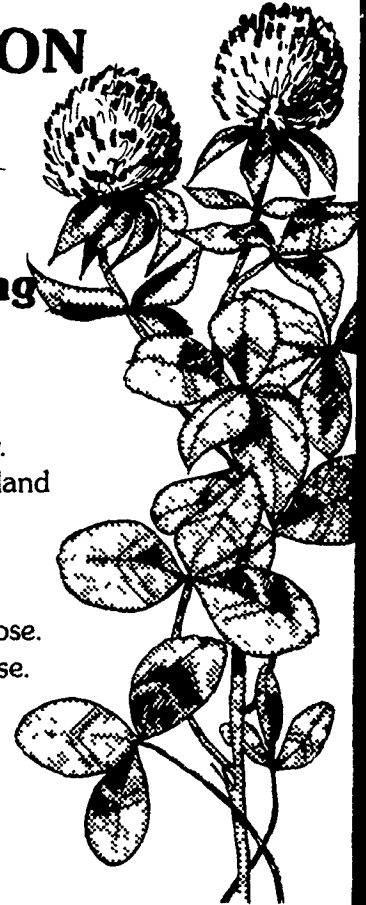

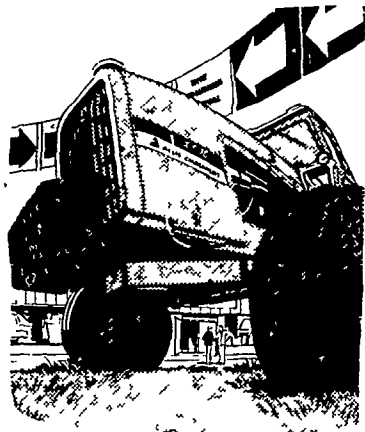
He is the author of a book and numerous journal articles. He has made several

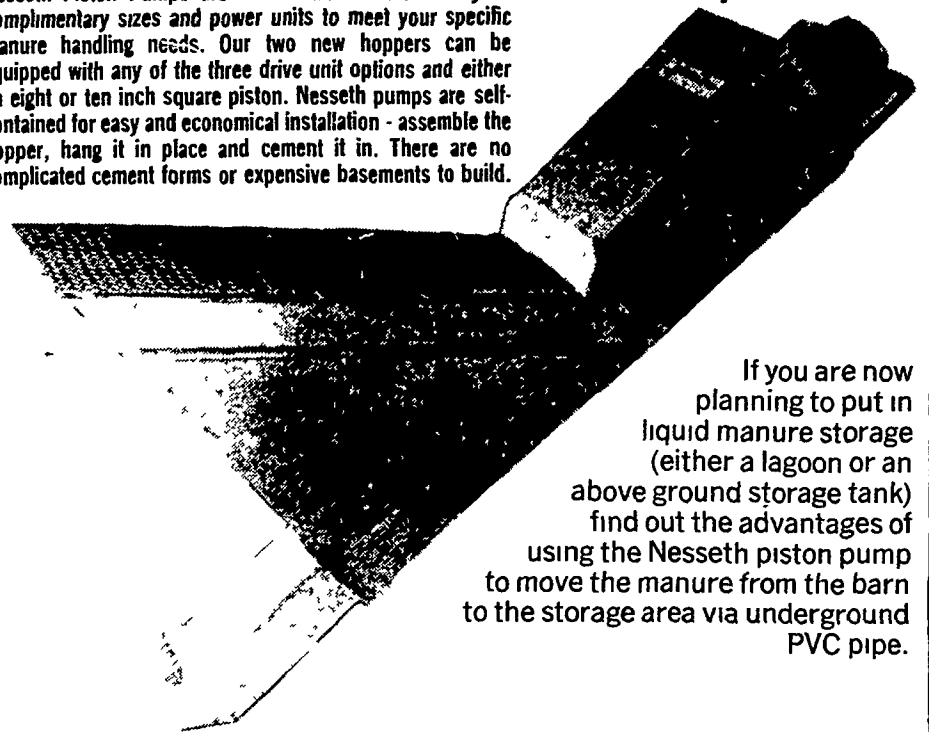
