promotion budget in 1978 will be \$3.2 million, with one half of this budget being used for what Norton called "hardcore advertising." There is a total of 19 million people in this area to-sell milk to, amounting to 17 cents per capita for advertising and promotion. "We need to be extremely efficient," Norton

Norton discussed the dietary goals which have been set by the Senate Select Committee on Nutrition and Human Needs and expressed concern that four of the seven stated goals for the country will affect the dairy farmer. One goal states: "substitute non-fat milk for whole milk," Norton said that in many schools, where USDA pays for 49 per cent of the lunch, two per
