



# Lebanon County DHIA Monthly Report

## JANUARY

Donald G. Hoffer's 5-year old Holstein, Number 38, was far out in front of her competitors in the milk category of the latest DHIA lactation report. Several cows in the county DHIA testing program compiled records in excess of 23,000 pounds of milk, but Number 38 was the only one to top 24,000 pounds. And she did it by a good measure. Her winning record stands at 24,581 pounds, with a 3.1 per cent test and 758 pounds of butterfat. The high cow for butterfat No. 106 is owned by the Lancaster Mennonite Hospital. Her completed lactation reads: 22,938 pounds of milk, 4.2 per cent, and 968 pounds of butterfat.
