Chester County DHIA Monthly Report

At 1195 pounds of butterfat, a Holstein in the herd of Jacob K. Stoltzfus produced the greatest amount of butterfat in the Chester County DHIA for the month of January. The six-year-old "L. Naomi" showed a 4.5 per cent test on her 26,782 pounds of milk to take the record.

A three-year-old owned by Ben S. Beiler produced 27,155 pounds of milk at a 3.7 test for 1004 pounds of fat. This ranks her next to the Stoltzfus cow in butterfat production.

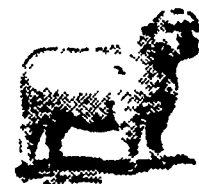
