New animal science dept. head named

DOVER Del. - Dr John K. Rosenberger, nationally recognized authority on poultry diseases, has been named chairperson of the department of animal science and agricultural biochemistry at the University of Delaware. He assumed his new duties January 16.

A familiar name to area poultrymen, Dr. Rosenberger in 1976 received the Delaware Poultry Industry Medal of Achievement Award for outstanding service on behalf of the in-

dustry. DPI recognized Rosenberger and co-winner Dr. Spangler Klopp for their research findings on anemia-dermatitis, a disease syndrome in broilers. On the basis of these findings, a vaccination procedure has been adopted that has saved area poultrymen millions of dollars.

The new chairperson is a native of Delaware and a graduate of Brandywine

High School in Wilmington. He holds bachelor and master degrees in animal science from the University of Delaware, and a Ph. D. in virology from the University of Wisconsin. He has been a faculty member at the University of Delaware since 1972.

Rosenberger is currently a member of the poultry health committee of Delmarva Poultry Industry, Inc.

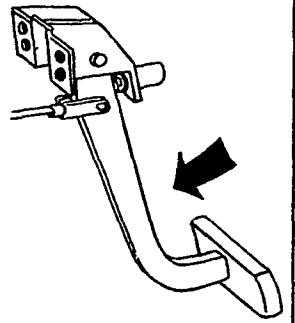

Auto Service Tips

Here's a simple brake test
Push pedal down. If it goes half-way to the floor, have them checked. The pedal should feel like it's hitting something hard. Sponginess could indicate air bubbles in brake lines. If you push down hard, count to ten and the pedal keeps going down, you could have master cylinder problems.
