Hog parasite control needed

DOVER, Del. - Mange mites and lice cause hundreds of thousands of dollars in profit loss to the swine industry. These tiny parasites can cause big problems by producing skin irritation that may lead to another disease. For example, lice carry swine pox. Secondary infections sometimes result.

According to Dr. Richard E. Fowler, Extension livestock specialist at the University of Delaware, the sarcoptic mange mite is a tiny round parasite that burrows under the outer layers

of skin and causes irritation and thickening of the skin. The mite feeds on skin, lymph and blood tissues. Each female mite lays about 50 eggs. The eggs hatch in four days. The mites become full grown in two weeks.

The lesion caused by mites resembles parakeratosis or zinc deficiency. Microscopic examination will differentiate the two. Mange mites cause irritation that makes infested animals scratch vigorously. In severe cases the entire body surface becomes affected with thick

scurfy skin. Feed intake decreases and weight gains fall rapidly. Advanced lesions may attract flies and further irritate the condition.

The hog louse continually punctures the skin in order to suck blood. A lousy hog will scratch and rub vigorously. Unlike the mange mite, the hog louse is visible without magnification - the adult females reaching a length of ¼ inch. Control is easy compared to mange mites. Some substances will kill lice but not mites. Good sanitation and frequent cleaning of pen environment can prevent lice and mange, according to the specialist.

Thorough spraying with high pressure allows penetration of the outer skin layers. The entire body should be covered with a repeat application one week to 10 days later, Fowler says.

Products that control lice include Ronnel, Coumaphos, Rabon, Ciovap, Lindane, Ciodrin, Malathion, Toxaphene and Fenthion (Tiguvon).

Recommendations are not included for sarcoptic mange of swine as this is considered a disease (drug use) rather than a pest problem. Farmers should contact their veterinarian for recommendations of substances to kill mange mites.
