Fulton Grange went on Grange No. 66, presided at 406, Printers No. 445, which would eliminate the power of the Salary Commission to establish salaries of state officials and representatives but only to make recommendations to the legislature. They opposed

H.B. 1614, Printers No. 1040, highway or solid waste which would allow holders of liquor licenses to set up establishments catering to the liquor trade and teenagers on the same property, even though in separate rooms.

House Bill 111, dealing with the condemnation of land for material, already passed unanimously by the House, is stalled in the Senate Appropriations committee. Fulton Grange voted to ask Pennsylvania senators to bring it out of committee and pass it. They favored H.B. 104, known as Agricultural Development Authority Act, designed to assist farmers to acquire land, equipment, and livestock.

They favored H.B. 1989 which would establish a committee to evaluate present state agencies at regular intervals to establish if they should be continued, terminated, or altered. They opposed H.B. 1855 which would foster a constitutional

amendment changing the 60 day residency requirement to vote to a period established by the state holds meeting legislature.
