FOR THE WEEK: Compared to late last week feeder cattle and calves closed \$1.00-3.00 higher; slaughter cows closed \$1.00-3.00 higher, late sales utility and commercial 2-3 32.50-36.50, cutter 1-3 28.25-33.50; bulls closed steady to firm, week sales consisted of yield grade 1-2 1000-1800 lb. 36.00-44.25; salable receipts near 16,800 head, compared to 20,343 head last week and 23,044 head the comparable week a year ago. Cows and bulls near 9 per cent of cattle receipts, feeders near 91 per cent of the total.

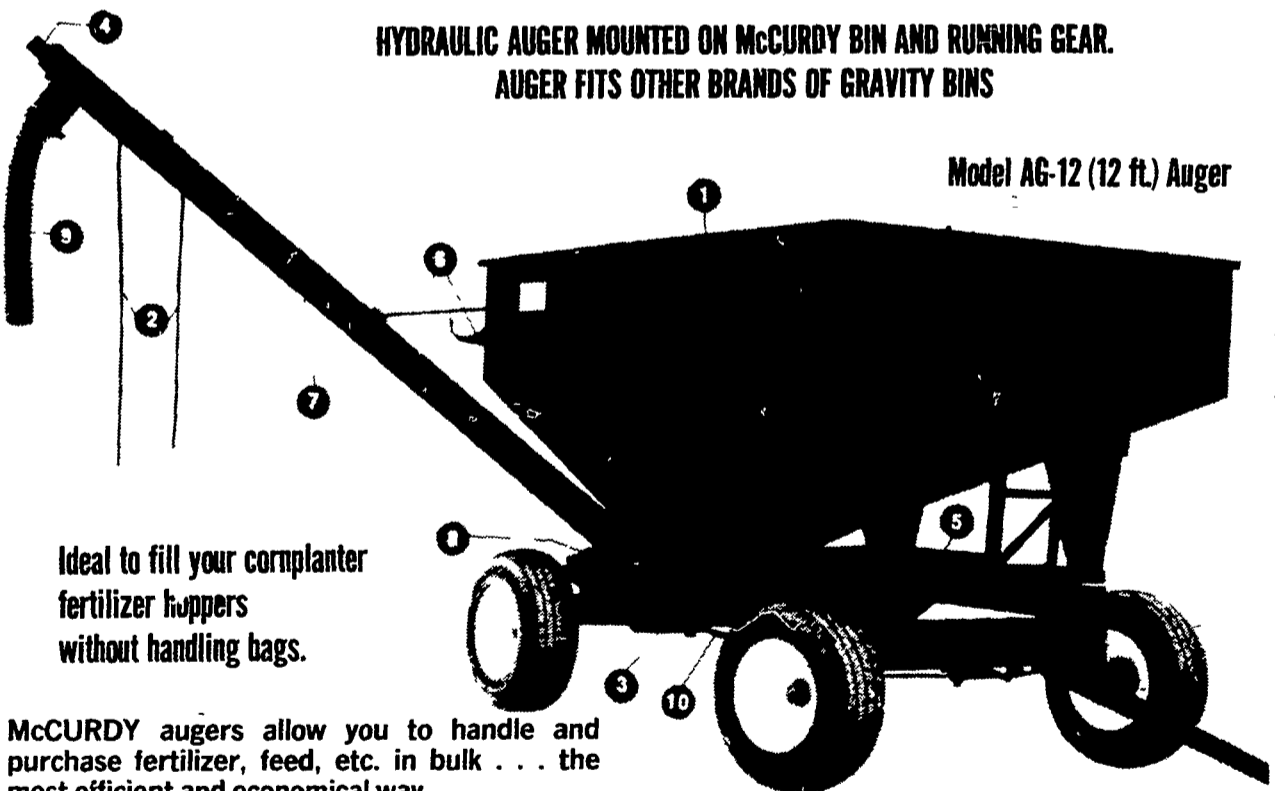

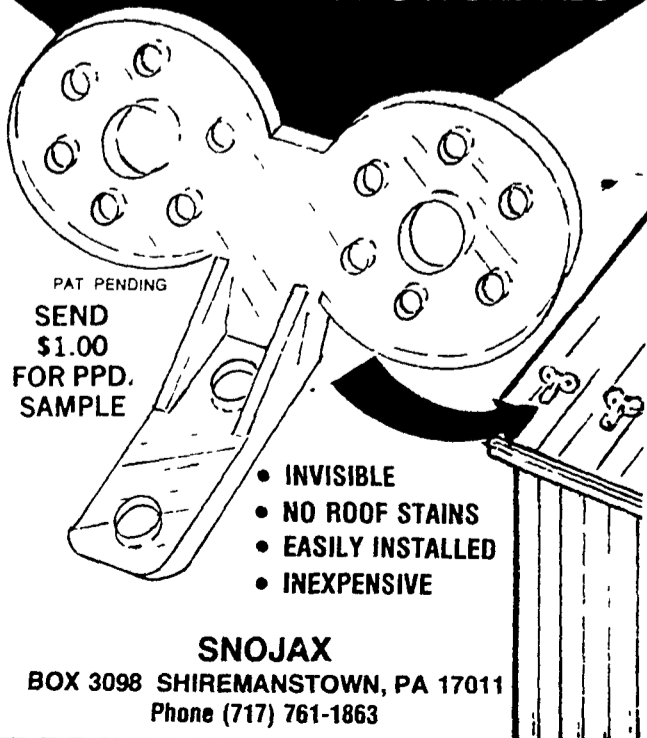
