XXX CRAB STUFFED POTATOES

4 medium Idaho potatoes

1 (6½ oz.) can crab meat

½ cup butter or oleo

½ cup light cream 1 teaspoon salt

4 teaspoons grated onion 1 cup sharp yellow cheese

½ teaspoon paprika

Pepper to taste

Scrub potatoes well; dry thoroughly. Put in oven and bake at 325°F. until you can pierce with fork. Cut the baked potatoes lengthwise and scoop out potato and whip with butter, cream, salt, pepper, onion and cheese. With fork mix in crab meat and refill the potato shells. Sprinkle with paprika and reheat in very hot oven about 15 minutes. These freeze nicely. Serves four.

YEAR ROUND MARKETING PAYS OFF

Besides speeding harvest by eliminating some dependence on other people our farm storage pays its way in higher prices. Table shows that if you had sold your crop in November every year, you would have received the lowest price of the year 13 out of 27 years. Highest prices were heavily concentrated in May through September and not once did lowest price of the year fall during this 5 month period!


