Fresh loins no comparison available, spareribs and Boston Butts steady, skinned hams steady - 1.00 lower, Bellies steady - 2.00 lower picnics not fully established.

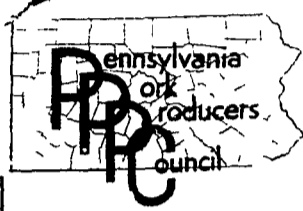

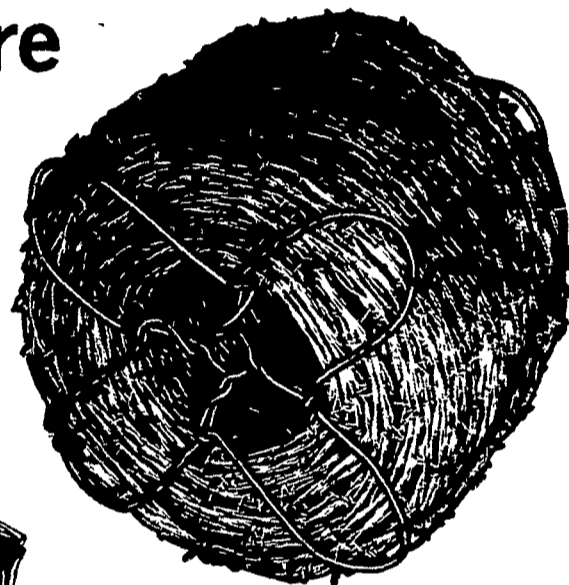
