Super ag agency proposed

WASHINGTON, D.C. - A new, super Food, Agriculture, and Renewable Resources Department would be created under a bill proposed by Senators Robert Dole and George McGovern. S.2519 has been introduced in the Senate and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs.

Essentially, the proposal would combine with the current Department on

Agriculture several functions of the Department of the Interior, and the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. Included from these Departments would be the Bureau of Land Management, except for the Office of Mines; Bureau of

Reclamation; Office of Water Research and Technology; U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service; U.S. Geological Survey; Bureau of Foods of the Food and Drug Administration; Bureau of Veterinary Medicine of the Food and Drug Administration.

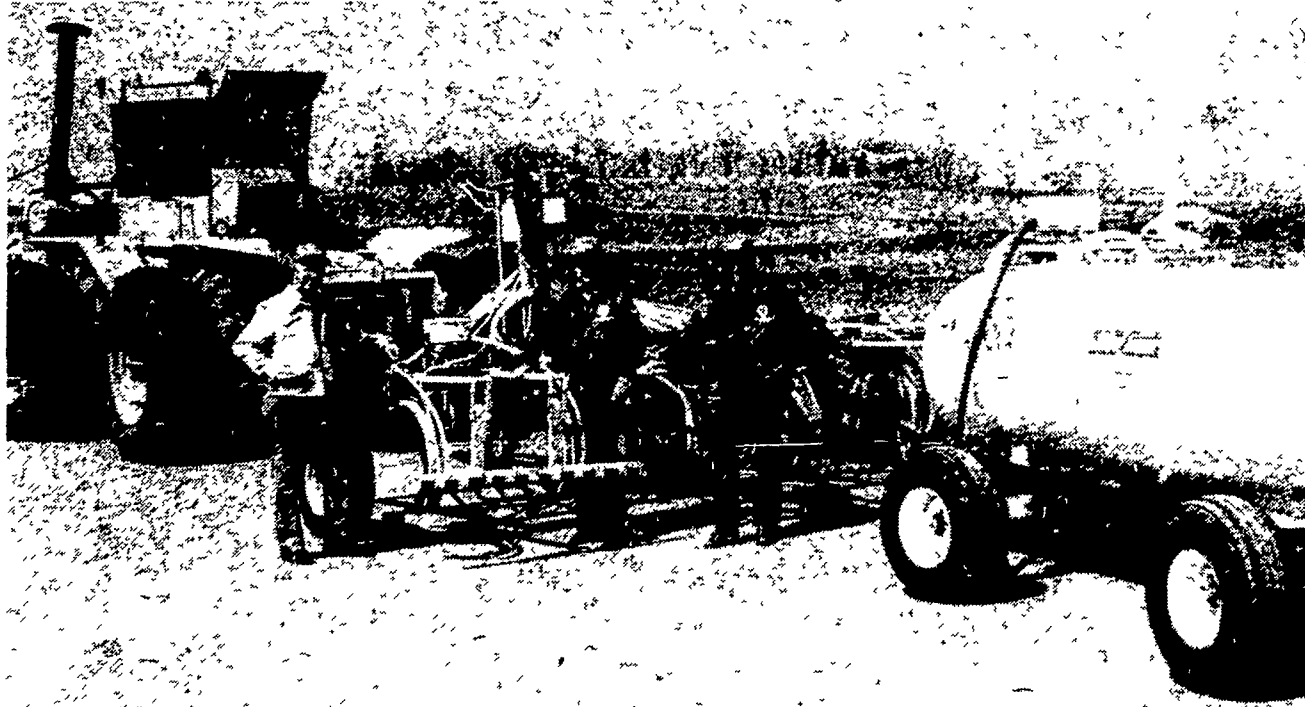
xxx SUPPORTING A HOUSE

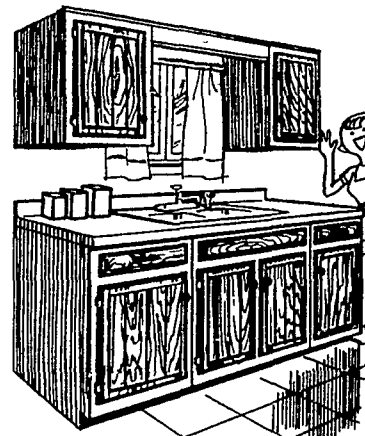

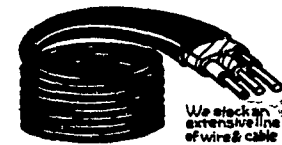

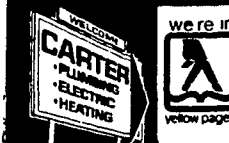
