The farm is supplied with water from a strong spring flowing out of the cellar, and providing a pond as shown. There is also a smoke house and storage building close to the house. The 2 story concrete block barn is 60 ft. by 80 ft. with a concrete barn floor, overhead barndoors and has no posts in barnfloor. Attached is a corn Barn forming an L. There is a 2 story concrete block 28 ft. by 60 ft. 4 stall garage and storage, with a 1 stall repair shop. There are 2, 10 by 50 concrete stave silos. Also a large Cattle scales.

Part No. 2, joins part 1 and consists of 15 acres more or less, with frontage on Cloverleaf Road at Rheems EXIT of Route 283, also bordering and overlooking Route 283. These 2 parcels will be offered separate and as a whole.
