Which are you using?

For post-emergence weed control in corn . . . what if 2,4-D doesn't work? Like on smartweed.

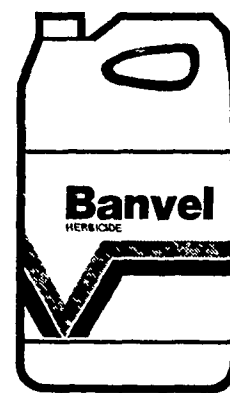
