

## Bergland seeks July 1 passage for farm production protection act

Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland is hoping for congressional approval of a crop disaster/crop insurance program by July 1 in order for actuarial work and other mechanics to be completed so that the new program could become operational on 1980 crops. The existing crop disaster program, under the 1977 Agricultural Act, expires in late 1979 and a new program will have to be ready when fall-seeded 1980

Agriculture subcommittee recently that if enactment is delayed much beyond July 1 it might be necessary to extend the current disaster programs for one more crop

program, known as the Farm Production Protection Act, would supplant the existing crop disaster provisions, the Federal Crop

Insurance Program, and Farmers Home Administration and Small **Business** Administration disasier loan programs.

(Continued from Page 117) completion of the fifty mile Ride and 24 hours are allowed for a 100 mile ride. These times include mandatory vet stops during which each horse's vital signs must reach standards set by the veterinarians who are officiating. At any indication that a horse is not up to the stress being asked of it, the animal is immediately disgualified from

the ride and a ride for the horse, in a trailer, is arranged.

Although horsemanship or Equitation, as such, is not judged in the sport, practical becomes horsemanship more and more important as the contest becomes harder or faster. A good rider who is fit and balanced is going to help his horse more than one who is not so skilled or athletically prepared.
