Malvin McGaha of the Fruit Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA, will report on the supply situation for competitive fruits.

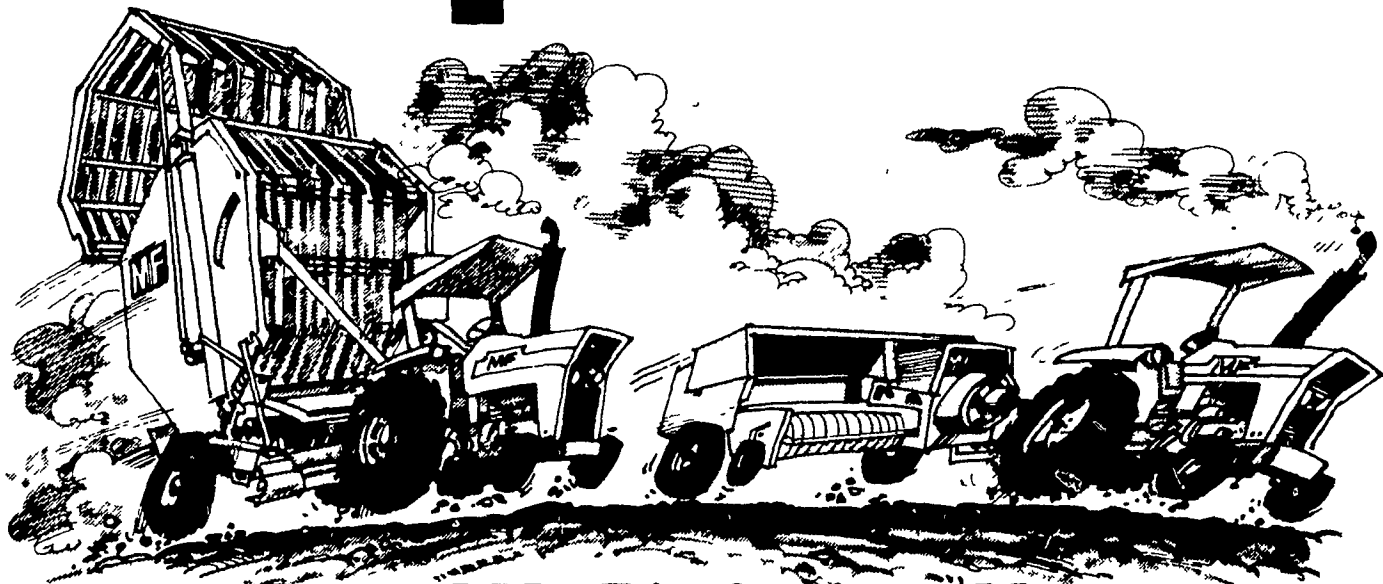

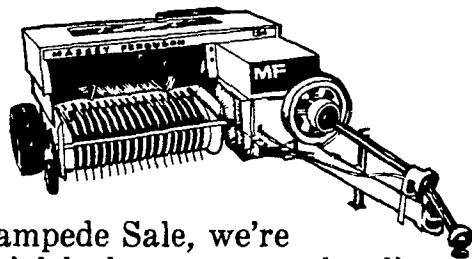

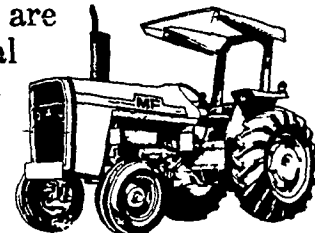
