Gypsy moths

(Continued from Page 37) the egg masses of the less mobile female can be transported from their original site.

Because of this, families moving household goods from eastern states to other parts of the country should be especially careful, officials say, to check vehicles and belongings likely to harbor the egg masses — hairy, buff colored mounds the size of a half-dollar.

Anyone finding an egg mass in an area already infested with gypsy moths should remove and destroy it. Anyone outside those areas who finds an egg mass is asked to report it to a federal or state plant protection and quarantine office, generally found in the telephone book in federal or state listings under "Agriculture."

Homeowners in light-to-moderately infested areas

should act now to help protect their trees and ornamental shrubs from gypsy moth caterpillars, according to USDA officials. Measures include:

—Putting a wide band of a sticky substance called tanglefoot around tree trunks to trap the caterpillars.

—Tying burlap or cloth strips around tree trunks. Caterpillars cluster under the strips and can be easily destroyed.

When an area becomes heavily infested, however, individual homeowners can do little to protect their trees, since gypsy moths will readily spread into their yards from infested neighboring properties. The best defense in such areas is community-wide action. Community leaders interested in gypsy moth control projects should contact their local county agricultural agent or state department of agriculture.

Strawberry roundup set

LANCASTER -- The Lancaster County - 4-H Strawberry Round-up will be held Wednesday, June 14, in the auditorium of the Lancaster Farm and Home Center. As in previous years, it is sponsored by the Lancaster Rotary Club.

All club members are to bring their strawberries to the Farm and Home Center by 10:00 a.m. Berries will be judged and record books scored by noon, after which the Rotary Club will treat the 4-H'ers for lunch. Immediately following will be the sale of strawberries to the Rotarians.

Each club member is asked to bring two quarts of hand-selected strawberries for judging purposes - plus eight to 10 quarts of additional berries to be sold. "Bring more if you have them because we will need all the berries that you have for the Rotarians to buy," says Extension agent Arnold Lueck.

"In addition, bring along your completed 4-H Strawberry Record Book. Cash awards will be given for the best exhibits of strawberries, as well as for the best total project score," Lueck explained.

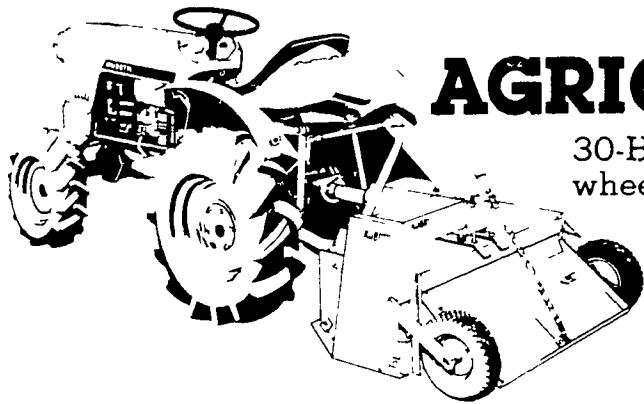

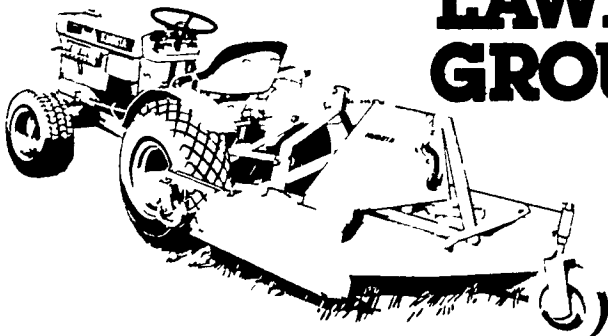

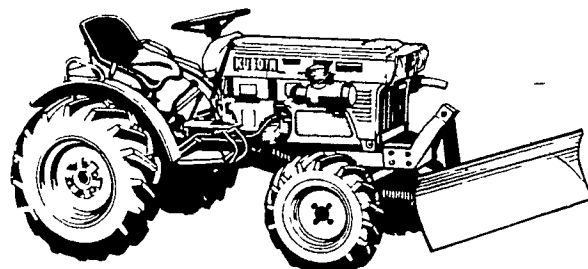
