Compared with previous Wednesday: slaughter steers and heifers were 3.50-4.50 lower through this Wednesday, largely 4.00 lower; instances 5.00 off on good and choice heifers. Few steers and heifers Thursday 5.00-6.00 lower. Cows closed .50-1.00 lower and bulls 1.00 off.

Four day receipts 14,000 as compared 15,300 previous week and 17,600 a year ago. Fed cattle prices again declined sharply despite moderate marketings

locally. Slaughter continued at the curtailed rate of recent weeks. The overall finish of the steer supply was fairly attractive with a rather liberal percentage of choice and several loads choice and prime. Much of the heifer supply was good to average-choice. Steers made up approximately 51 percent and heifers 31 percent of receipts. Cows a short 10 percent and feeders 6 percent.

STEERS: At midweek, load Choice 3 and two loads Choice and Prime 3-4 1280-1460 lbs. 55.00, scattered loads 1125-1300 lbs. 54.50, the week's high Monday and Tuesday 56.00, but load 1250 lbs. Thursday 53.00. Choice 2-4 1000-1300 lbs. closed Wednesday 52.00-54.00, largely 52.50-54.00, but few loads 1075-1175 lbs. Thursday 51.00-52.25. Mixed Good and Choice 2-3 975-1250 lbs. Wednesday 50.50-52.50. Good 48.00-51.00. Few Standard and Good 45.00-48.00, some Good and Choice 1425 lb. Holsteins 49.00 Wednesday.

Average of LS-214, detailed quotations, for Choice 900-1100 lb. steers this week 52.80; Choice 1100-1300 lbs. 53.40. Average weight steers first three days 1134 lbs. as compared 1154 lbs. previous week. Average weight heifers first three days 977 lbs. as compared 989 lbs. previous week.

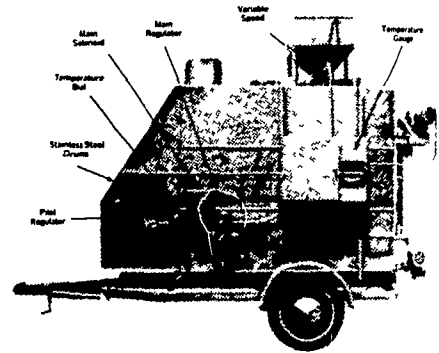

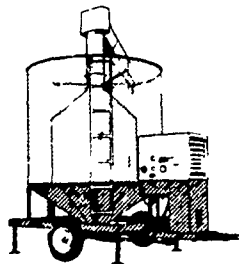

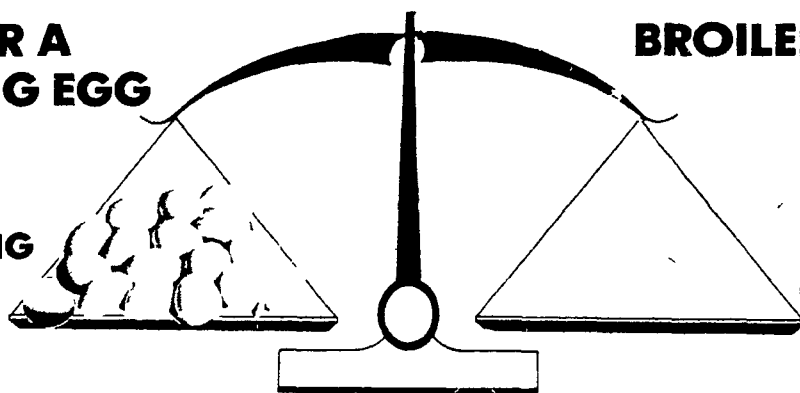
