The first three places in

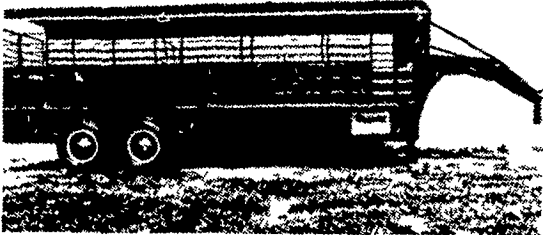
each division are eligible to participate in the Grooming and Showmanship class at county 4-H. All participants are eligible to enter other

Increase Your Alfalfa Yields?

Look at these test results:

First cutting Nothing was added to normal fertility program.

Second cutting: 3 gallons 9-18-9 or 10-20-10 plus one gallon MEDINA. Each cutting then had the same treatment, only at the half-gallon rate on MEDINA.

Sixth was not cut due to wet fall in 1977. It is most unusual for the later cuttings to be better than the first two.

The 9-18-9 used in this test was Na-Chures Other 9-18-9 or 10-20-10 should perform in a similar manner

Every alfalfa grower knows that normally the first two cuttings are the highest yielding. We changed that — Perhaps you can too. Be sure to apply the MEDINA and fertilizer (water may be added) within 5 days after cutting — 3 to 5 days are best 10-20-10 or similar fertilizer should work equally well. Try this program on your hay

MEDINA may be mixed with all insecticides and fungicides and with liquid and dry fertilizer.
