According to Dr. Lowell L. Wilson, Penn State professor of animal science, the entries were judged on taste, appearance, originality, ease of preparation, and practicality.

The event featured beef recipes during Pennsylvania Beef Week, June 18-24, and was aimed at helping the public understand the various cuts of beef and their proper preparation.

Contest judges were Mrs. Ralph Dotterer, of Lamar,

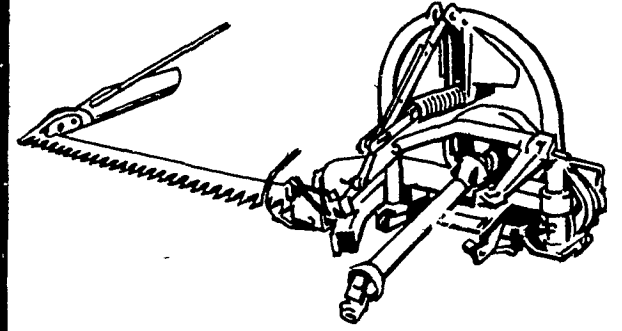
