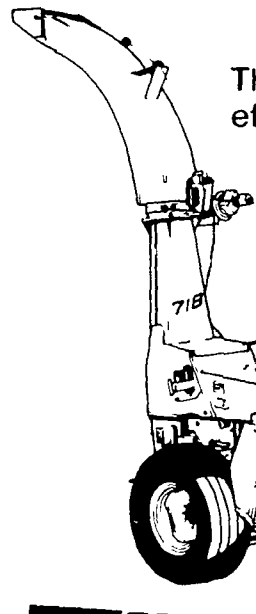

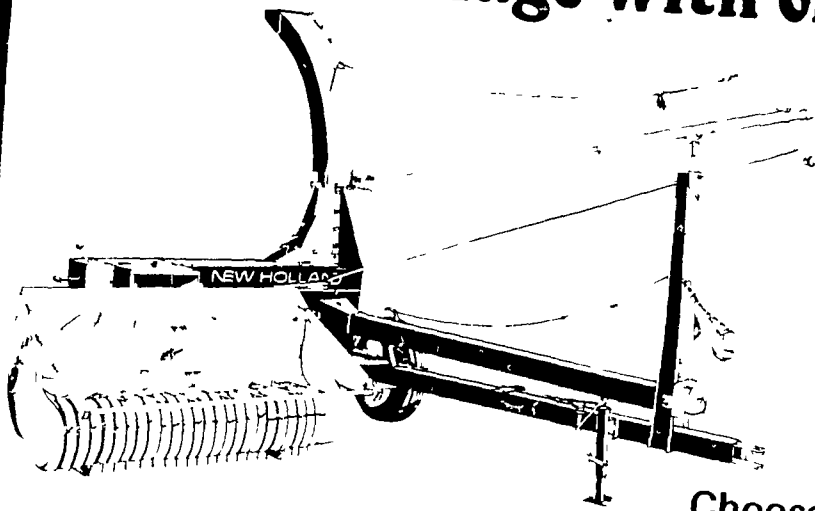


The idea behind the Sperry New Holland Model 718 Forage Harvester is efficiency obtaining a fine uniform cut with low power requirements.

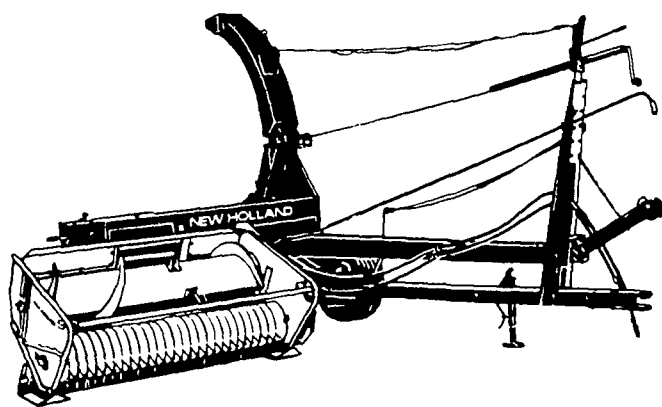


The Sperry New Holland Model 770 forage harvester features a 12-knife cutterhead and a PTO-driven power knife sharpener. You also get
