Omaha Cattle

July 27, 1978
 Cattle - Through midweek, slaughter steers were 50-1.00 higher than previous Wednesday after losing part

of a sharper early week advance. Heifers were 1.00-2.00 higher. Cows closed 4.00-5.00 higher, bulls 1.00-2.00 higher.

Four day receipts 12,900 compared 14,900 previous week and 17,400 a year ago. Packers were in need of immediate slaughter requirements and responded to small early week marketings by pushing slaughter steer and heifer prices up sharply. Although marketings and slaughter remained moderate, packers turned cautious again by this midweek. Some local packers continued out of the market due to plant renovation and vacations. Slaughter steers made up approximately 45 per cent of the total weeks

receipts, heifers 33 per cent with a fair percentage choice included. Cows made up 7 per cent and feeders 14 per cent of the week's total.

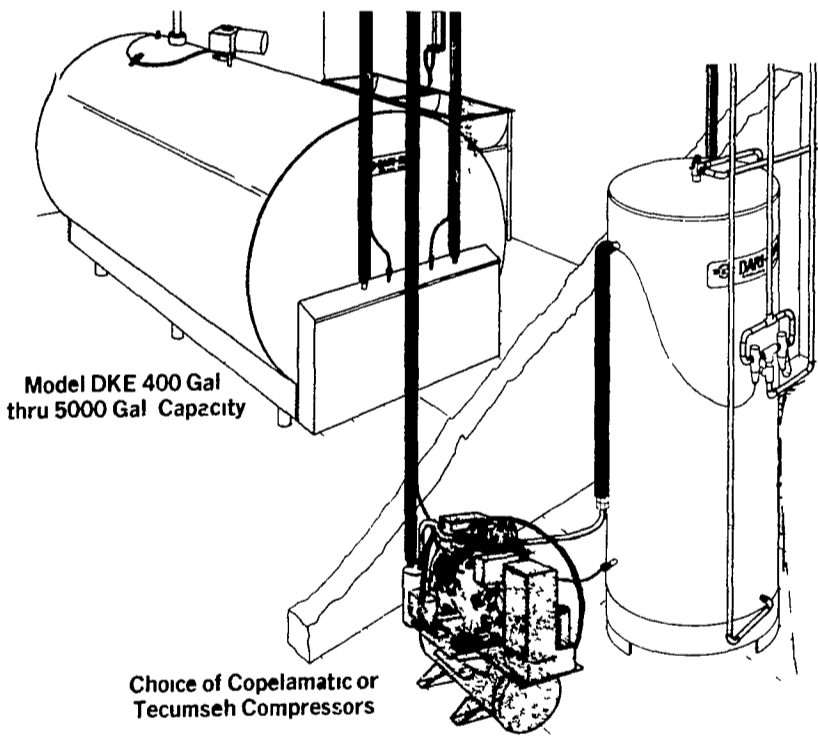

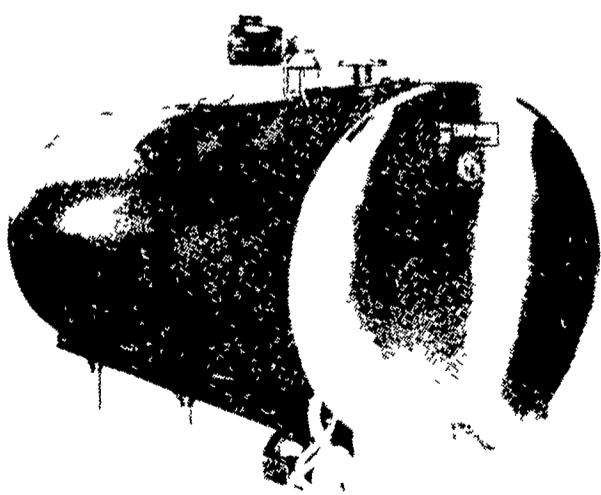
