

# Lebanon 4-H Holstein show results posted

LEBANON — Kirby Horst had a dream come true when he won the championship title of the Lebanon Fair's annual 4-H Holstein show. His winning entry was an aged cow named Ed-Min Sparky-red, a daughter of C Romandale Shalimar Magnet, which stood as both senior and grand champion. Winning the contest here, which was held on Tuesday, is an accomplishment which had eluded the young Lebanon County dairyman for years. He won it twice this year, however, taking the senior and grand championship honors in the FFA show as well. The winning cow in that contest was a 6-year old daughter of Penn-Gate Reflection Admiral. The reserve senior and reserve grand champion banners were won by Michael Bare, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Hershey Bare, Lebanon, whose 3-year old daughter of Valley-Pond Astrocount stood first in her class and went on to win the runner-up honors.

A Glenafton Rag Apple Hagen daughter brought into

the ring by Nelson Bomgardner of Ono captured the judge's eye for junior champion distinction. A senior yearling, the junior champion is named Loving Meadows Hagen Molly. Daryl Balmer of Lebanon had the reserve junior champion, a junior yearling sired by Life-O-Riley Marquis King.


