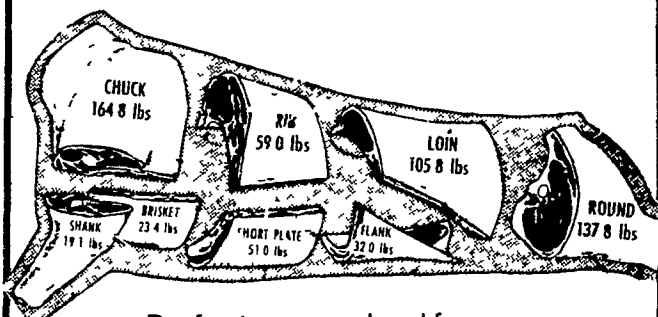

## Sheep producers urged to vote 'yes'

PARK RIDGE, Ill. - Sheep producers are being urged by the American Farm Bureau Federation to cast an affirmative vote in a referendum August 21 to September 1 that will determine if a national lamb and wool promotion program is to be continued.

Richard W. Owens, AFBF secretary and chief administrator, said the AFBF Board of Directors took action to support passage of the referendum after reviewing AFBF policy and a recommendation by its sheep advisory committee.

Owens said the \$2,200,000 (fiscal year 1978-79) promotion program will be handled by the American Sheep Producers Council, Inc., established under the National Wool Act of 1954.

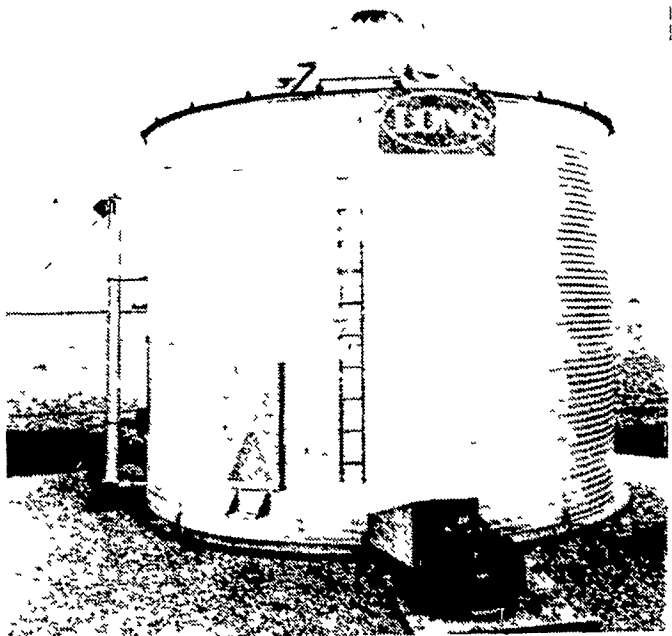
ASPC, headquartered in Denver, is financed by

deductions from producer incentive payments. If approved in the referendum, deductions will be increased from one and one-half cents per pound on shorn wool to two and one-half cents. Deductions for unshorn lambs will be increased to twelve and one-half cents per hundredweight from seven and one-half cents.

The referendum will be run by county offices of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service which will distribute information and ballots to sheep producers in mid-August. Anyone who owned sheep six months old or older for at least 30 consecutive days during 1977 can vote.

Owens added that sheep producers have approved the ASPC wool and lamb promotion in six referendums since 1954.

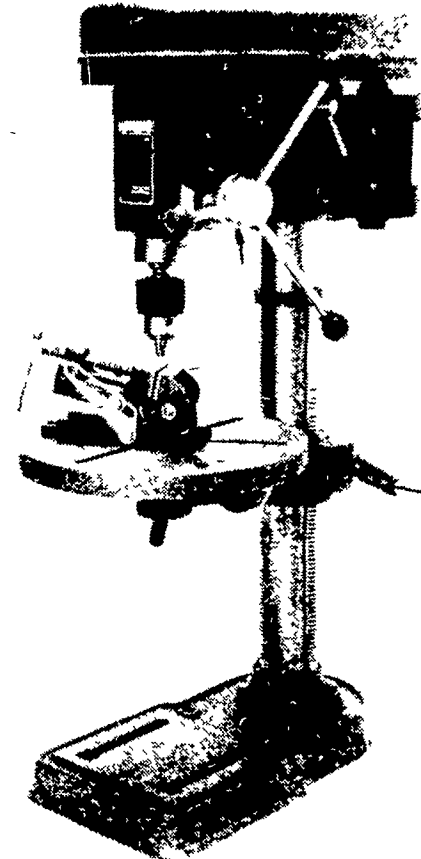
