2 teaspoons cinnam
2 teaspoons ginger
add sugars and beat untul light and fluffy. Add until one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add molasses. Sift flour, salt, bakung soda, and spices together and blend into the first mixture. Stir until well blended.
Chill. Shape into balls about the size of a bing cherry and drop in granulated sugar. Coat all over with sugar and place on a greased baking sheet. Bake for 12 to 15 minutes in a moderate oven at 375 F . or untul lightly browned.

$41 / 2$ teaspoons baking soda 2 teaspoons salt
3 cups chopped raisins
Mix shortening, melted margarine, sugar, and eggs. Add milk and lemon extract Sift flour, cream of tartar baking soda, and salt together. Add dry ingredients and chopped raisins to mixture. Roll in balls the size of walnuts. Flatten slightly with a fork Bake at $400^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. for 10 minute or until done. This recipe makes about 11 dozen cookies.
