### **COWBOY COOKIES**

1 cup granulated sugar 1 cup brown sugar 1 cup shortening 2 eggs 2½ cups flour ½ teaspoon salt

8 oz. chocolate chips

1 teaspoon vanılla Cream sugar and shortening together, then add eggs and beat well. Sift flour, salt, baking soda, and baking powder together and add to creamed mixture. Add oatmeal, chocolate chips, coconut, and vanilla. Stir well. Drop onto cookie sheets and bake at 350°F. until done.

11/2 cups shortening 1 cup brown sugar 1 cup granulated sugar 2 eggs

½ cup molasses 5 cups flour ½ teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon cloves 2 teaspoons cinnamon 2 teaspoons ginger

3 teaspoons baking soda

Cream shortening, then add sugars and beat until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add molasses. Sift flour, salt, baking soda, and spices together and blend into the

first mixture. Stir until well

blended. Chill. Shape into balls about the size of a bing cherry and drop in granulated sugar. Coat all over with sugar and place on a greased baking sheet. Bake for 12 to 15 minutes in a moderate oven at 375 F. or

Mix shortening, melted margarine, sugar, and eggs. Add milk and lemon extract. Sift flour, cream of tartar, baking soda, and salt together. Add dry ingredients and chopped raisins to mixture. Roll in balls the size of walnuts. Flatten slightly with a fork. Bake at 400°F. for 10 minutes or until done. This recipe makes about 11 dozen






