

## Cover crop plans due

NEWARK, Del. — Now is the time to plan for a late Summer or Fall seeding of clover or vetch in your corn fields. Either one of these legumes will provide a good soil cover during the Winter months and release as much as 100 pounds of nitrogen to next year's corn crop.

With seed so much in demand, it would be wise to order your own supplies early this year, cautions University of Delaware extension agronomist Dr. William H. Mitchell.

Cover crops establishment has been field-tested for the past two years by

agronomists at the University of Delaware Agricultural Experiment Station and some of the reasons for poor quality stands have been identified.
