Loans slowing

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Lending by the cooperative Farm Credit System grew at a slower rate during the year ended June 30 than in previous years, but the system set new records in loan volume and loans outstanding, Donald E. Wilkinson, governor, Farm

Credit Administration, reported recently.

The system loaned \$39.6 billion during 1977-78, an 8 per cent increase from 1976-77, Wilkinson said. Its loans outstanding at June 30 totaled \$44.9 billion — up 11.4 per cent from June 30, 1977.

Dairy vote due

PITTSBURGH — Dairy farmers shipping milk to the Eastern Ohio-Western Pennsylvania milk marketing area are reminded that votes on the recent decision to amend the federal milk order must be postmarked no later than Aug. 14.

The proposed amended order concerning payment, pooling, and other provisions were based on a public hearing held in Cleveland, Ohio, October 12-14, 1977.

Market Administrator Cleo C. Taylor said a notice of referendum—a decision which contains the provisions of the proposed amended order—and a ballot were mailed Aug. 4 to all known eligible voters.

Each producer is entitled to one vote regardless of the number of farms he operates. Partnerships, corporations and other business organizations which operate dairy farms are entitled to only one vote regardless of the number of partners, shareholders, or

others which make up the organization.

Qualified cooperative associations of producers may cast block votes on behalf of members on all provisions of the amended order; however, no proxy votes are permitted.

Taylor said that eligible dairy farmers who may not have received a ballot through the mail should call the USDA Referendum Agent at Area Code 216, 826-3220.
