second overall in the identification competition, with a score of 226 points. Lisa Dobrosky was third with 223 points, Steve Trostle ranked fourth with 213 points and Brenda Walters finished close behind in fifth with 212 points.

In the presentation of reasons, the York County team members took the top four spots. Lisa Dobrosky ranked first with 93 points, followed in second place by Chris Sunday garnering 89 points. Brenda Walters was third with 89 points and Steve Trostle took fourth place with 87 points.

Lisa Dobrosky racked up 577 points in the judging to finish up with the first place high individual overall. Chris Sunday took the second spot with 564 points. Brenda Walters- finished sixth with 515 points and Steve Trostle wound up seventh with 512.

York County's team totaled 1656 points to top second place Westmoreland County's 1446 points. Lancaster took third with 1417 points, Fayette was fourth with 1343 points and Beaver finished fifth with 1179 points.

Brenda Werner was named senior high individual after accumulating 414 points. In third place was Tim Beck with 401 points. Harris Wright and Dave Wise garnered 387 and 351 points respectively.




