

Gail Snyder wins Kutztown Fair Sheep Show

KUTZTOWN — A market lamb shown by Gail Snyder, New Tripoli, in the heavyweight class captured the grand championship placing at the Tuesday sheep show at the Kutztown Fair. The lamb which weighed 110 pounds was from a western ewe and a Dorset ram.

It was a good day for Miss Snyder who not only won that honor but was also named the grand champion fitter at the show and the reserve grand champion showman.

Marlyn Stroh, II, Breinigsville R2, also a member of the Lehigh County 4-H sheep and lamb club, showed the reserve champion market lamb. His entry was a Hampshire which weighed 104 pounds.

Marlyn also placed first in the junior division of the fitting contest, second in the junior showmanship contest, and the champion Hampshire ewe at the fair.

Two sisters, Melissa and Sarah Fretz, Zionsville R1, captured first place in their respective sheep blocking

contests, beating all the other competition. Sarah also had the reserve champion Hampshire ewe while Melissa placed first in the intermediate showmanship class.

Bonnie Horning 16, of Orefield R2, a Lehigh County FFA'er of two years' experience was named the grand champion showman of the fair.

In the breeding sheep classes, the champion and the reserve champion Cheviot ewe was shown by Charles Hopkins, Oley R1.

The Shropshire champion ewe was shown by Keith Breininger, New Tripoli R2, showing a yearling. The son of Donald Breininger, he too is a member of the Lehigh County sheep club. Dwayne Reinert, Slatington R2, showed the reserve champion ewe, from the lamb class.

The Angelo Baroni family of Downingtown captured the Dorset championships with Ann Baroni winning the championship with her yearling ewe and her brother

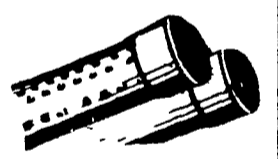

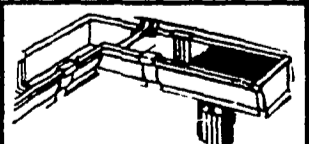

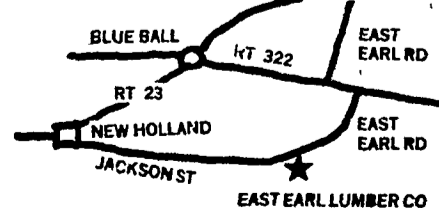
