GNR eggs are classified by weight in 30-dozen cases, and traded in lots of either 300 or 750 cases. Prices are FOB buyers dock, and are computed Tuesday and Thursday of each week. Ready-to-cook movement very slow and disappointing with occasional load of heavy weights reported sold as low as 41 cents for Friday delivery. Slaughter schedules moderate. Today's LTL asking prices mostly 43 on plant and 44 on U.S. grade A. Advance interest generally slow in developing however, several loads noted at 43 cents on plant grade for next week booked this a.m. Live supplies ample at weights in a wide range tending heavier than desired in some quarters.

Undertone unsettled.

Negotiated-trucklot prices 2-3 lb. ready to cook broiler/fryers for Plant grade 43. Current broiler/fryer negotiated prices for immediate includes-mostly multiple-drop shipments to New York City from Delmarva.

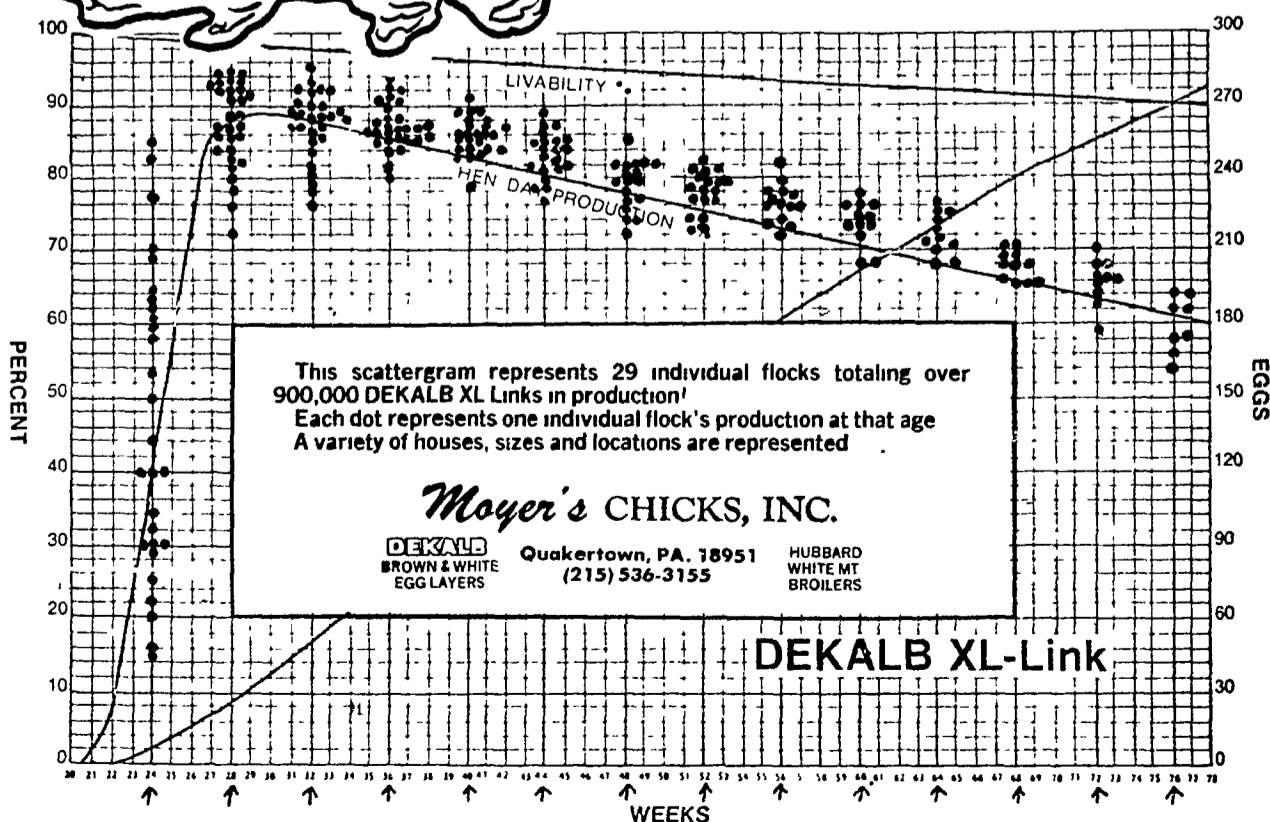
