MANHATTAN — Treating corn silage with a commercial enzyme product (and its co-factors) increased beef production in a Kansas State University study.

K-State researchers report that a ton of treated silage produced 7½ pounds more gain (105.5 vs. 98) than a ton of untreated silage.

Both treated and untreated silages (about 65 percent moisture content) were ensiled in upright concrete silos. The treatment product was provided by International Stock Food, Inc., of Waverly, N.Y.

Steers fed treated corn silage gained only slightly faster and more efficiently than steers fed untreated corn silage. The product's greatest benefit was in preservation and recovery of nutrients contained in the corn silage. Researchers said only 6.3 percent of the treated silage was lost during fermentation and storage compared with 12.6 percent for the untreated silage.

Analysis of the treated and untreated silages at MacDonald College at McGill University, showed higher lactic and propionic acids in the treated silage. The K-State and MacDonald scientists indicated further enzyme product research is in progress.
