

'Omelet King' sets world record

ANAHEIM, Calif. — The American Egg Board's Howard Helmer came to town to set the world record for omelet making. And he chose the grand opening of the American Egg House at Disneyland where the cameras would record the event.

began with six pans, 500 cracked and beaten eggs, 30 minutes worth of sand in the hour glass and a host of supporters -- including Mickey Mouse.

Nationally known in the egg industry as the Omelet King, Howard was out to top the existing Guinness Book of World Records for omelet

making. He needed 189 to top the record of 188 two-egg omeletes cooked in thirty minutes by Clement Raphael Freud of Nottingham, England.

The specially designed glass enclosed omelet cooking area of the American Egg House may have been the perfect setting for Howard's feat but it caused a problem for the omelet maker.

By the time he had flipped out number 15, beads of perspiration ran down his face, at number 50 he was drenched with sweat.

"I was sweating so hard, the perspiration was drip-

ping into the hot pans and exploding all over the place," Howard recalled. "My biggest problem was trying to keep the hot popping grease off me."

But in spite of the popping grease, when the crowd chanted down the last ten seconds, a triumphant Howard emerged with 217 omelets to his credit, a new world's record and a special place for himself in the Guinness Book of World Records. The crowning touch came from Mickey Mouse who planted a sign proclaiming Howard as "World Champion Omelet Maker" in the last record breaking omelet.
