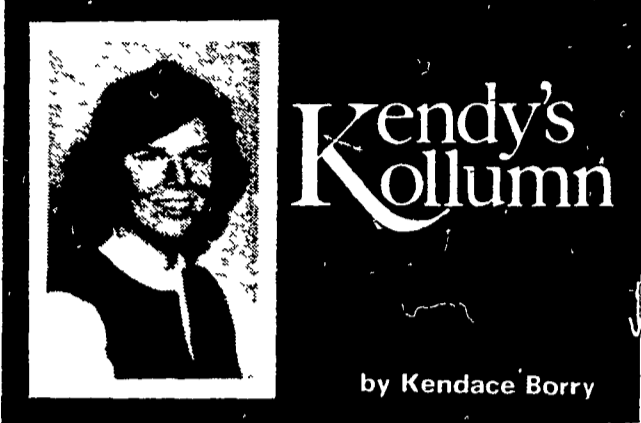
Lancaster Co. Society 5

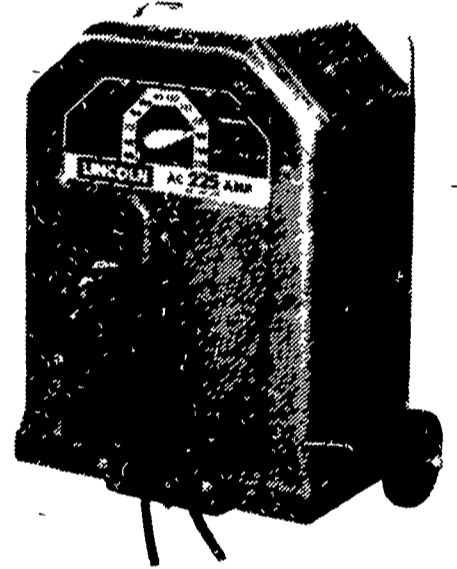

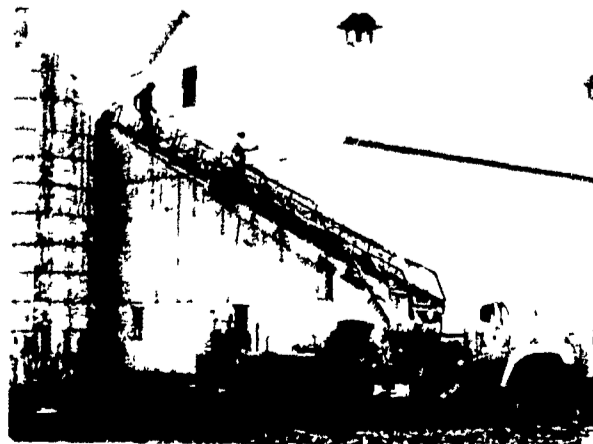
