

### Greenhouse course offered

UNIVERSITY PARK — Small greenhouses can fill a flower lover's needs. For plotted plant culture and year round cut flower production, they are essential. Autumn is a good time to build a small greenhouse.

There are two basic types: the lean-to or attached, and the free standing. The type one selects varies with his home structure and should be well built.

Extending the length of growing season is the main reason for having home greenhouses.

Artificial heat must be provided. Hot air, steam and hot water are ways to distribute heat. A person's selection will depend on the size of greenhouse, availability of fuels, possibility of using his home heating system, cost of installing, and maybe other factors.

Once the greenhouse shell has been erected, benches, watering devices, shelves, and other conveniences must be selected and installed. Personal preference and size of greenhouse determine the kind one chooses.

To teach small greenhouse construction and management, Penn State offers correspondence course "The Home Greenhouse." Kinds of houses and building details are explained.

### Horse course offered

UNIVERSITY PARK — Available from the Correspondence Course office at Penn State is a course on light horses.

Rewritten by Dr. Thomas L. Merrit, professor of animal industries at Penn State, the 11-lesson course discusses: horse anatomy and selection; reproduction; parasites; buildings; equitation; training; breeds; stable management; and unsoundness.

According to the course, practice and training of both


horses and riders are necessary for satisfactory performance. Riders must control their mounts and control is centered on the mental, not the muscular activities of the horse.

To help one enjoy horse ownership more, a person should send for the course. Intended for the beginners, the information is valuable to members of riding clubs,

and individuals who expect to buy a horse.

One can get the course by sending \$6 to Light Horses, Box 5000, University Park, Pa. 16802, making the check payable to Penn State.




