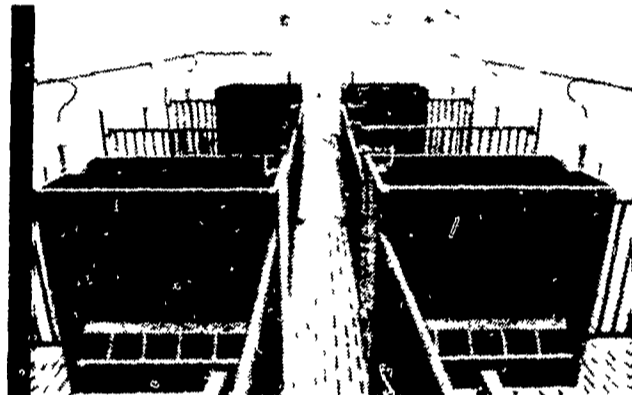

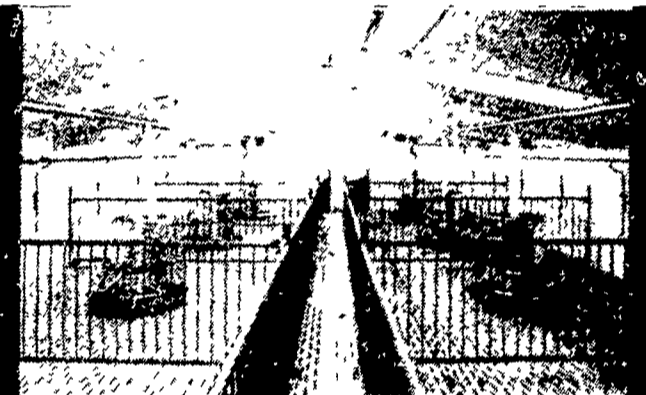

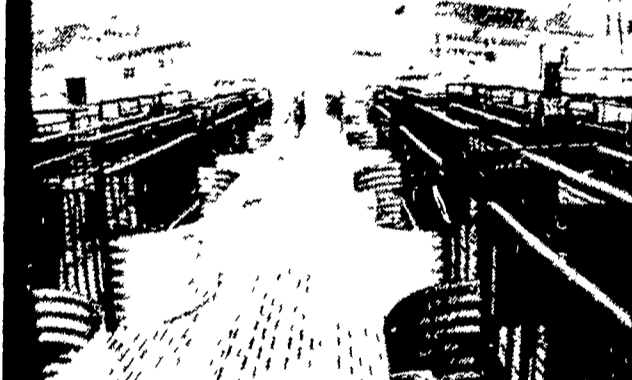
PIG CAPSULE

SOW CAPSULE

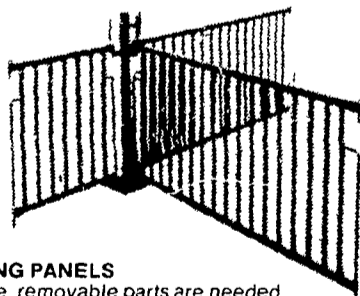
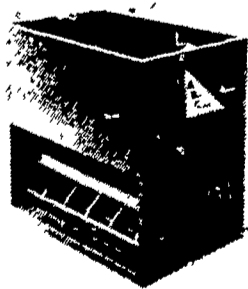

SOW-PIG CAPSULE

A good farrowing system for medium or small operations. A farrowing building is combined with pig nursery pens. You have choices of models from 4 farrowing stalls with 2 nursery pens to 16 stalls and 8 pens.

The Ag Best nursery feeder has an expanded throat that helps eliminate packing and bridging. An easy top adjustment regulates feed flow. A step-back feeder design keeps manure from dropping in the trough. Five partitioned feeding spaces on each side. Capacity is 11 bushels. Construction is 14-gauge welded steel.



NURSERY AND FINISHING PANELS

Built in one piece. No loose, removable parts are needed. Panels open from either end and swing both ways. Posts have a unique latch with pull and twist action for instant release or positive catch. (patent pending)

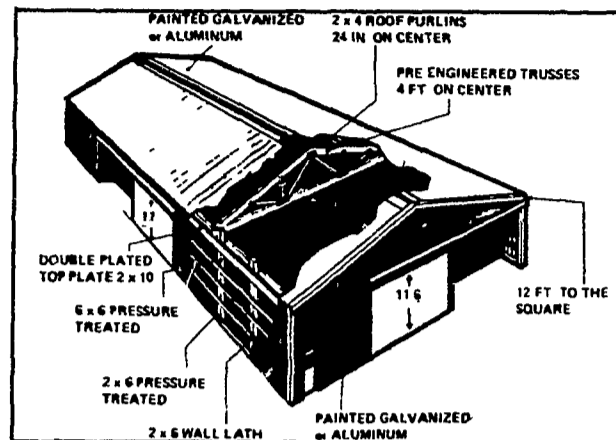
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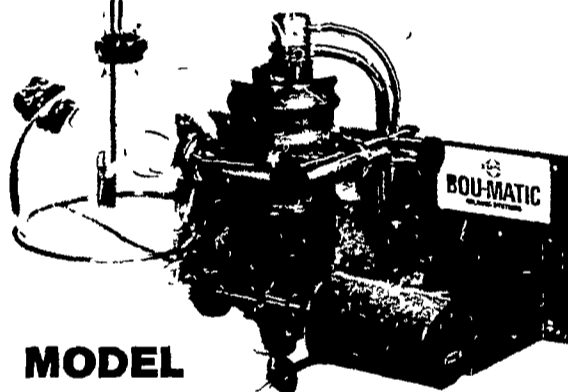
