Second place went to "Gyp" and "Dick," a team owned by Larue Austin, Columbia Cross Roads, Pa. They pulled the 8030 pound load 10'1".

Search Dalyrmple, Hampton, was third with "Bill" and "Harry." They managed to pull the load 7'1". Fourth place went to Alpaugh Bros., Lebanon; fifth to Roger Hall, Delhi, New York.


