Jersey cattle bring highest all-time average

demand for Jersey cattle and top-quality consignments combined to give the Pennsylvania State Jersev Sale its highest alltime average. Sponsored by the Pennsylvania Jersey Cattle Club, the sale was held on September 16 at the Guernsey Pavilion near Lancaster. The thirty-four registered animals sold for an average of \$1091.91, with sixteen animals topping the \$1000 mark. The cattle sold into Virginia, Maryland, Connecticut, Ohio, and Delaware, as well as Pennsvlvania.

Top cow in the sale at \$1825 was a fresh 3-yr-old, Wilderness Tillyson Dusty, consigned by Dr. and Mrs. Robert Dreisbach of Hamburg, and purchased by Paul and Charlotte Trimble of Peach Bottom. Second high at \$1800 was a 4-yr-old Quicksilver cow consigned

LANCASTER - Strong by Robert Eick of Columbia Cross Roads and purchased by Waverly Farm, Clearbrook, Va. Roller Jersey Farm of Timberville, Va., purchased Quicksilver Forester Caper from Rupert Jerseys of New Waterford, Ohio, for \$1775. Also topping the \$1700 mark was Smokey Hill Generator Helen, consigned by Roy Watson of Columbia Cross Roads and purchased by Terry Lee Rhein of Pine Grove. Top buyers of the day were Paul and Charlotte Trimble who purchased four animals for \$5450.

> Also sold were five heifer calves in the Second Pennsylvania Pot of Gold Sale. There animals, available only to junior buyers, will return money to their purchasers based on their twoyear-old milking records. Top calf sold was Masters Merry Sonia, consigned by Pioneer Farm, Old Lyme,

Conn., and purchased by 16,326 lbs. of 4 per cent fat-Katherine Knowlton, Harwinton, Conn., for \$650. Second high calf was a Supreme Virginian daughter consigned by Eugene and Brian Harris of Milan and purchased by Brian Watson of Columbia Cross Roads.
