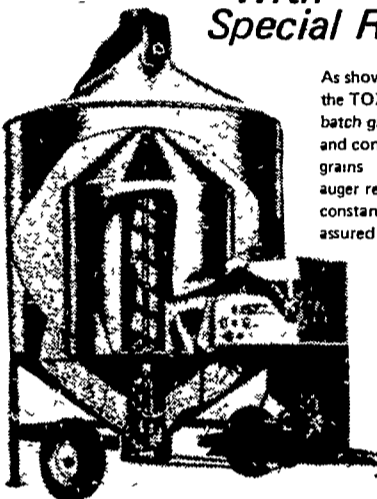

WHAT'S NEW

RECORD SYSTEM

A new record keeping system has been announced by the Temple Tag Division of Zoecon Industries.

The program, called "The Herdsman", has been available from local dealers and distributors of Temple Tags since September 1. It consists of a permanent records book and various working records for use in the field.

The kit consists of the following:

1. A permanent records book to hold a history sheet on each head of stock - a vinyl covered, hardback three-ring binder measuring 8 1/2 inches by 15 inches.

2. A 9 inch by 13 1/2 inch folding vinyl covered clipboard that, along with a "Performance Pad" and a "Breeding Pad," will serve as working tools to gather information in the barn or pens for subsequent transcribing to the permanent record.

3. A 3 inch by 5 inch

"Pocket Guide" that provides space for the most pertinent entries about each head so it can serve as a quick identification tool and guide in the field.

Further information on The Herdsman system and how to use tags for identification is provided in a brochure that may be obtained by writing The Herdsman, Temple Tag Company, Temple, Texas 76501.
