

Grange supports bill to protect farm land

HARRISBURG - In an interview in Lancaster last week, J. Luther Snyder, Master of the Pennsylvania State Grange, repeated his organization's support for the Agricultural Districts Bill presently being considered by the State Senate.

One of the main intents of this bill, is to keep agricultural land in farming.

If passed, this bill will protect farmers from ordinances that might in-

tertere with farming practices.

The bill also makes it more difficult for the farmer to lose his land under eminent domain.

"This bill," said Snyder, "will make government agencies think twice before they try to use prime farmland for any use other than farming."

In order to qualify for an agricultural district, a

landowner or group of landowners must submit a proposal to their local governing body.

The minimum amount of land eligible under this bill is five hundred acres.

The proposed district may consist of two or more unconnected properties that do not border one another.

"The best thing about this bill," said Snyder, "is that it is voluntary. The farmer does not have to enroll in this program if he doesn't want to."
